A trip that will bring us near the understanding of the cosmos in the Mapuche culture and in contact with 2 glaciers.

This trip begins sharing with the indigenous community Andrés Huenupi in the Melipeuco community y and its Llin Llin Wenu trail, at the Llaima lookout, after which we will enter ancient Araucaria forests in the immediate vicinity of the Sollipulli volcano, which we will ascend to touch the glacier that covers the great side of this sleeping giant, obtaining incredible 360° views of the main peaks in the region, continuing with horseback riding and a night's rest in the indigenous community's refuge, ending with a journey to the Sierra Nevada glacier, where we will top off our senses with one of the most beautiful postcards of the incredible Conguillío National Park.
